## Goal

Our goal for 2015-2016 school year is to have a 1% school wide increase in the overall rate of passing grades. We will increase the 2014-2015 passing rate from 96.9% to 97.9% passing rate for the 2015-2016 school year.

This increase in passing grades will represent increased student learning. We will compare the rate of passing for the school years 2014-2015 with 2015-2016 to see if we achieve our goal. Right now we have half of our baseline data for the 2014-2015 school year which is 96.9% rate of passing. We will attain the rate of passing for the remainder of the year once school has concluded, so that we have the entire baseline data needed to measure the rate of success of our new goal.

# **Action Plan Steps**

This is the Action Plan Steps identified in the plan to reach the goal.

As a school the most important step in achieving our goal is to improve our Tier 1 instruction. This improvement will largely take place through the collaboration process and professional development. We are going to use some of our trust lands monies to provide extra paid collaboration time to our teachers during the summer of 2015. We will be concentrating on D.O.K. (Depth of Knowledge) which will improve the educational process for all students at Canyon View Jr. High. We do realize that we need some very prescriptive interventions to help certain groups of students who are at-risk. We will provide four semester long classes of read 180 for our lowest readers. These students are identified by SRI and by teacher recommendations. We are also going to provide a guided studies aide to work with students who have not achieved mastery after initial instruction. These students are recommended by teachers/counselors for this class. There are eight sections of this class provided with about 15 students per section. We have a disproportionate number of our Latino students receiving failing grades at our school. We are going to provide an advocate who will work to provide better communication with our Latino parents on how their students are doing here at CVJH academically and the varied programs that their students can access to get academic help. For our 9th grade students who fail a class beginning 1st term we will provide credit remediation classes. These are small group classes (10-12) students in each, where they access on-line packet classes. The aide who runs these classes monitors their progress and helps students with any questions they have as they work through the curriculum.
